EVENT: LP = leaving port, AP = arrival, CC = change course, CE = change effort, S = cetacean sighting, T = turtle sighting, OT = other
EFFORT: (how we stratify data for analyses) 0 = no effort, 1 = sea state 1 with a mast lookout, 1S = sea state 1 without a mast lookout, 2 = sea state 2 with a mast lookout, 2S = sea state 2 without a mast lookout, 3 = sea state 3 with a mast lookout, 3S = sea state 3 without a mast lookout
WORKING CONDITIONS: (this is a category summing up numerous conditions e.g. sea state, swell, wind force, glare etc.) 1 = excellent, 2 = good, 3 = fair / moderate, 4 = poor, 5 = mixed working conditions
FORM NUMBER: Form number used at top of the sightings log, also same as primary number on Logger for cetaceans.
SIGHTING NUMBER: Sighting of the year used at the top of the sightings log, number of actual cetaceans / turtles seen this field season.
